## House Bill 2972

Sponsored by Representative DOHERTY

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Repeals pilot project requiring Department of Transportation to enter into contract for private maintenance of segment of state highway. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to a pilot project for private maintenance of a state highway; repealing sections 23 and 24,

3 chapter 865, Oregon Laws 2009; creating new provisions; and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Section 23, chapter 865, Oregon Laws 2009, as amended by section 68, 6 chapter 545, Oregon Laws 2011, is repealed.

7 (2) Section 24, chapter 865, Oregon Laws 2009, is repealed.

8 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The repeal of Section 23, chapter 865, Oregon Laws 2009, as amended by 9 section 68, chapter 545, Oregon Laws 2011, and section 24, chapter 865, Oregon Laws 2009, 10 does not affect a contract made before the effective date of this 2013 Act. Section 1 of this 11 2013 Act, however, applies to a renewal or extension of an existing contract on or after the 12 effective of this 2013 Act as well as to a new contract made on or after the effective date 13 of this 2013 Act. 14 SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
