CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to a pilot project for private maintenance of a segment of a state highway; creating new provisions; repealing sections 23 and 24, chapter 865, Oregon Laws 2009; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) Section 23, chapter 865, Oregon Laws 2009, as amended by section 68, chapter 545, Oregon Laws 2011, is repealed.

(2) Section 24, chapter 865, Oregon Laws 2009, is repealed.

SECTION 2. The Department of Transportation shall terminate contracts the department entered into under section 23, chapter 865, Oregon Laws 2009, as amended by section 68, chapter 545, Oregon Laws 2011, immediately or as soon as is feasible in accordance with the terms set forth in the contracts for terminations for convenience or, if appropriate, as provided for a termination because of a lack of sufficient appropriations or a lack of legal authority to engage in the work described in the contract. The department, in terminating the contracts, shall perform all obligations and duties that the contract requires of the department upon termination.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
