

House Bill 2973

Sponsored by Representative DOHERTY

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Repeals pilot project requiring Department of Transportation to enter into contract for private maintenance of segment of state highway. Directs department to terminate contracts entered into for pilot project as soon as feasible.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to a pilot project for private maintenance of a segment of a state highway; creating new
3 provisions; repealing sections 23 and 24, chapter 865, Oregon Laws 2009; and declaring an
4 emergency.

5 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

6 **SECTION 1.** (1) **Section 23, chapter 865, Oregon Laws 2009, as amended by section 68,**
7 **chapter 545, Oregon Laws 2011, is repealed.**

8 **(2) Section 24, chapter 865, Oregon Laws 2009, is repealed.**

9 **SECTION 2.** **The Department of Transportation shall terminate contracts the department**
10 **entered into under section 23, chapter 865, Oregon Laws 2009, as amended by section 68,**
11 **chapter 545, Oregon Laws 2011, immediately or as soon as is feasible in accordance with the**
12 **terms set forth in the contracts for terminations for convenience or, if appropriate, as pro-**
13 **vided for a termination because of a lack of sufficient appropriations or a lack of legal au-**
14 **thority to engage in the work described in the contract. The department, in terminating the**
15 **contracts, shall perform all obligations and duties that the contract requires of the depart-**
16 **ment upon termination.**

17 **SECTION 3.** **This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
18 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**
19 **on its passage.**
