

# House Bill 2986

Sponsored by Representative DEMBROW

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Transportation to work with Department of Corrections, after consultation with Judicial Department, to assist individuals in obtaining driver license after release from Department of Corrections institution.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to driving privileges; amending ORS 802.087.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 802.087 is amended to read:

5 802.087. (1) The Department of Transportation and the Department of Corrections jointly shall  
6 adopt rules and enter into interagency agreements necessary to assist offenders in obtaining a driver  
7 license or identification card prior to an offender's release from a Department of Corrections insti-  
8 tution.

9 (2) **After consultation with the Judicial Department, the Department of Transportation**  
10 **and the Department of Corrections jointly shall adopt rules and enter into interagency**  
11 **agreements necessary to assist individuals in obtaining a driver license after release from a**  
12 **Department of Corrections institution.**
