B-Engrossed House Bill 3035

Ordered by the House June 27 Including House Amendments dated April 23 and June 27

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Directs [Transparency Oregon Advisory Commission] **Oregon Department of Administrative Services** to develop plan for providing information, on Oregon transparency website, relating to contracts entered into by state agencies, school districts and community colleges. Requires that plan be completed on or before January 1, 2015.

Limits, for biennium beginning July 1, 2013, expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Oregon Department of Administrative Services Chief Information Office for expenses incurred in implementing Act.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to the Oregon transparency website; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) On or before January 1, 2015, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall develop a plan for providing the following information, or providing links to the following information, on the Oregon transparency website:
- (a) Information on expenditures made by state agencies under contracts, including the text of the contracts and information on the work to be performed, or products or services to be provided, under the contracts.
- (b) Information regarding the terms of state agency contracts that is listed by categories, such as contracts not yet completed and anticipated completion dates, in a manner that allows persons accessing the website to search each category separately.
- (c) Information regarding vendors and other contractors under state agency contracts that is listed by categories, such as city, state and zip code of a vendor's or contractor's residence, in a manner that allows persons accessing the website to search each category separately.
- (d) Findings or determinations under ORS 279B.030 and 279B.036, and supporting documentation for those findings or determinations.
- (e) Annual revenue, annual expenditures and contracting and subcontracting information for school districts and community colleges.
- (2) On or before February 15, 2015, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall report to the Legislative Assembly, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, the details of the plan developed under this section.
 - SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$21,120

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23 24 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services Chief Information Office for administrative and operating expenses incurred in implementing the provisions of this 2013 Act.

SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
