

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3035

By COMMITTEE ON CONSUMER PROTECTION AND GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “amending ORS 184.483” and insert “and declaring  
2 an emergency”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 31 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) On or before January 1, 2015, the Transparency Oregon Advisory Com-**  
5 **mission shall develop a plan for providing the following information, or providing links to the**  
6 **following information, on the Oregon transparency website:**

7 **“(a) Information on expenditures made by state agencies under contracts, including the**  
8 **text of the contracts and information on the work to be performed, or products or services**  
9 **to be provided, under the contracts.**

10 **“(b) Information regarding the terms of state agency contracts that is listed by catego-**  
11 **ries, such as contracts not yet completed and anticipated completion dates, in a manner that**  
12 **allows persons accessing the website to search each category separately.**

13 **“(c) Information regarding vendors and other contractors under state agency contracts**  
14 **that is listed by categories, such as city, state and zip code of a vendor’s or contractor’s**  
15 **residence, in a manner that allows persons accessing the website to search each category**  
16 **separately.**

17 **“(d) Findings or determinations under ORS 279B.030 and 279B.036, and supporting doc-**  
18 **umentation for those findings or determinations.**

19 **“(e) Annual revenue, annual expenditures and contracting and subcontracting informa-**  
20 **tion for school districts and community colleges.**

21 **“(2) On or before January 1, 2015, the Transparency Oregon Advisory Commission shall**  
22 **develop a plan for regularly updating the information on the Oregon transparency website**  
23 **in a manner that promotes the goal of accuracy.**

24 **“(3) On or before January 1, 2015, the Transparency Oregon Advisory Commission shall**  
25 **develop a long term vision and plan for the Oregon transparency website, with an emphasis**  
26 **on ease of use.**

27 **“(4) On or before January 1, 2015, the Transparency Oregon Advisory Commission shall**  
28 **report to the Legislative Assembly, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, the details of the**  
29 **plans developed under this section.**

30 **“SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
31 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**  
32 **on its passage.”.**
