On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, delete "and 201.340" and insert ", 201.340 and 202.180". 1 2 On page 6, after line 29, insert: "SECTION 6. ORS 202.180 is amended to read: 3 "202.180. (1) The county court of a new county or a county to which territory has been added 4 $\mathbf{5}$ shall, respectively: 6 "(a) Cause all the registration [cards] records of electors living in the new county or in the 7 territory that has been added to an existing county to be segregated from the registration 8 [cards] records on file in the counties from which the new county is created or the county from 9 which the territory has been removed; 10 "(b) Cause the registration **records** to be delivered to the county clerk of the new county **or** 11 the county to which the territory has been added; and 12"(c) Provide for the transfer to the county clerk of the new county or the county to which the 13 territory has been added a list of electors and other election records, relating only to precincts 14 and electors within the new county or the territory that has been added to an existing 15county. 16 "(2) The county clerk of the new county or the county to which the territory has been added 17 shall arrange and install the registration [cards] records received under subsection (1) of this sec-18 tion in the manner provided by law. The registration [cards and] records constitute registration of 19 the electors whose names appear [thereon] on the records in the new county or the county to 20 which the territory has been added, respectively. 21"(3) The list of electors and other registration and election records are records of the new 22county or the county to which the territory has been added, respectively. 23 "(4)(a) If a county boundary change occurs on a date within a period described in para-24 graph (b) of this subsection, the change is not effective for purposes of eligibility for 25elections within the territory that is removed from one county and added to another county 26until the day after the respective ending date described in paragraph (b) of this subsection.

"(b) The periods referred to in paragraph (a) of this subsection are the periods:

28 "(A) Beginning on the day after the 90th day before a primary election or a general 29 election and ending on the day of the election; or

30 "(B) Beginning on the day after the deadline for filing the notice of election before any 31 election, other than a primary election or a general election, that is held by a county, district 32 or other municipal corporation affected by the boundary change and ending on the day of the 33 election.".
