## House Bill 3082

Sponsored by Representative KOMP; Senator GIROD

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires State Board of Education to adopt rules requiring provision of fluoride rinse to certain students and children after certain meals.

Requires Department of Education to solicit names of dentists who provide dental services at reduced rates for, or who volunteer to provide dental services at no charge to, students of lowincome families and to post names and other related information on department's website.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to dental care for children.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The State Board of Education shall adopt rules requiring:

5 (1) Public and private prekindergarten through grade 12 schools and residential child care

6 facilities to provide students and children with a fluoride rinse after serving a meal in ac-

7 cordance with rules adopted by the board under ORS 326.051 (2)(c);

- 8 (2) School districts to provide students with a fluoride rinse after serving a meal in ac-9 cordance with rules adopted by the board under ORS 327.527; and
- (3) School districts to provide students with a fluoride rinse after serving a meal as part
  of program for which a school district receives funding under ORS 327.535 or 327.540.
- 12 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Department of Education shall solicit the names of licensed dentists 13 who provide dental services at reduced rates for, or who volunteer to provide dental services
- 14 at no charge to, students of low-income families.
- 15 (2) The department shall post the names of dentists described in subsection (1) of this 16 section on the department's website along with:
- 17 (a) Contact information for the dentist;
- 18 (b) Qualifications for receiving dental services from the dentist; and
- (c) The amount the dentist charges to provide dental services to students of low-income
  families.
- (3) The Oregon Board of Dentistry and the Oregon Health Authority shall assist the de partment in acquiring the information required by this section.
