

# House Bill 3105

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Creates offense of unlawful parking in space reserved for alternative fuel vehicle refueling. Punishes by maximum fine of \$250.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to parking offenses.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) A person commits the offense of unlawful parking in a space reserved for**  
5 **alternative fuel vehicle refueling if the person parks a vehicle in any parking space that is**  
6 **on premises open to the public and that is marked or signed as reserved for alternative fuel**  
7 **vehicle refueling and the vehicle is not engaged in the refueling process.**

8 **(2) As used in this section, "alternative fuel vehicle" has the meaning given that term in**  
9 **ORS 469B.100, except that "alternative fuel vehicle" includes vehicles registered in any ju-**  
10 **risdiction.**

11 **(3) The offense of unlawful parking in a space reserved for alternative fuel vehicle refu-**  
12 **eling is a Class D traffic violation.**
