House Bill 3105

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Creates offense of unlawful parking in space reserved for alternative fuel vehicle refueling. Punishes by maximum fine of \$250.

2	Relating to parking offenses.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) A person commits the offense of unlawful parking in a space reserved for
5	alternative fuel vehicle refueling if the person parks a vehicle in any parking space that is
6	on premises open to the public and that is marked or signed as reserved for alternative fue
7	vehicle refueling and the vehicle is not engaged in the refueling process.
8	(2) As used in this section, "alternative fuel vehicle" has the meaning given that term in
9	ORS 469B.100, except that "alternative fuel vehicle" includes vehicles registered in any ju
10	risdiction.
11	(3) The offense of unlawful parking in a space reserved for alternative fuel vehicle refu
12	eling is a Class D traffic violation.
