House Bill 3109

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Director of Oregon Health Authority to report regarding forest fire impacts on public health, fish and wildlife and river habitat to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to general government matters no later than October 1, 2013.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to forest fire impacts; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Director of the Oregon Health Authority shall prepare a report regarding the impacts of forest fires on public health, fish and wildlife and river habitat and submit the report, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to general government matters no later than October 1, 2013. The report may include recommendations for legislation to prevent or reduce the impacts of forest fires on public health, fish and wildlife or river habitat or to improve state or local government responsiveness to forest fire impacts that threaten public health, fish and wildlife or river habitat.

SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
