## House Bill 3111

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Directs State Treasurer to promote childhood financial literacy education.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to duties of the State Treasurer; amending ORS 178.050. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: **SECTION 1.** ORS 178.050 is amended to read: 4 178.050. The State Treasurer shall: 5 (1) Keep the office at the seat of government. 6 (2) Receive and have charge of all moneys paid into the State Treasury. (3) Pay out moneys from the State Treasury as directed by law. 8 9 (4) Permit the books, papers and transactions of the office to be open at all times to inspection and examination by the Governor, Secretary of State, the legislature and any committee of either 10 11 branch of the legislature. (5) Deliver over to the successor in office all moneys, books, papers, furniture and other effects 12 belonging to or preserved in the office. 13 14 (6) Promote childhood financial literacy education. 15 [(6)] (7) Perform all other duties imposed upon the State Treasurer by law.
