House Bill 3127

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Creates subtraction from taxable income for mileage of volunteers. Applies to tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2013. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to income tax subtractions for mileage of volunteers; and prescribing an effective date.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 316.

5 SECTION 2. In addition to the other modifications to federal taxable income contained

6 in this chapter, a taxpayer is allowed a subtraction for use of the taxpayer's motor vehicle

7 in the performance of volunteer services. A taxpayer may subtract from federal taxable in-

8 come an amount equal to 42.5 cents per mile multiplied by the number of miles driven in the

9 performance of volunteer services.

10 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Section 2 of this 2013 Act applies to tax years beginning on or after January
11 1, 2013.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2013 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2013
regular session of the Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.

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
