

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3149

By COMMITTEE ON HIGHER EDUCATION AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 31.
- 2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 4 and insert:
- 3 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Community College Child Care Services is estab-**
4 **lished.**
- 5 **“(2) The task force consists of members appointed as follows:**
- 6 **“(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint one member from among members of the**
7 **Senate.**
- 8 **“(b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one member from among**
9 **members of the House of Representatives.**
- 10 **“(c) The Commissioner for Community College Services shall appoint members who rep-**
11 **resent community college administrators, community college faculty, community college**
12 **students, the board of education of a community college district, advocates for community**
13 **colleges, advocates for students in post-secondary education, the Department of Community**
14 **Colleges and Workforce Development and the Child Care Division of the Employment De-**
15 **partment. At least two members of the task force must be community college faculty and**
16 **at least two members of the task force must be community college students.**
- 17 **“(3) When selecting members of the task force as provided by subsection (2)(c) of this**
18 **section, the Commissioner for Community College Services shall:**
- 19 **“(a) Consult with any applicable employee associations to solicit recommendations for**
20 **persons who are full-time community college faculty and persons who are part-time com-**
21 **munity college faculty.**
- 22 **“(b) Consult with duly organized and recognized entities of student government to solicit**
23 **recommendations for persons who are community college students.**
- 24 **“(4) The task force shall:**
- 25 **“(a) Study the cost of providing child care services to students of community colleges;**
26 **and**
- 27 **“(b) Identify sources for funding the cost of providing child care services to students of**
28 **community colleges.**
- 29 **“(5) Members of the Legislative Assembly appointed to the task force are nonvoting**
30 **members of the task force and may act in an advisory capacity only.**
- 31 **“(6) A majority of the voting members of the task force constitutes a quorum for the**
32 **transaction of business.**
- 33 **“(7) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the voting**
34 **members of the task force.**
- 35 **“(8) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as chairperson.**

1 **“(9) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority shall make an appoint-**
2 **ment to become immediately effective.**

3 **“(10) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chair-**
4 **person or of a majority of the voting members of the task force.**

5 **“(11) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.**

6 **“(12) The task force shall submit a report, and may include recommendations for legis-**
7 **lation, to the interim legislative committees on education no later than September 1, 2014.**

8 **“(13) The Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development shall provide**
9 **staff support to the task force.**

10 **“(14) Notwithstanding ORS 171.072, members of the task force who are members of the**
11 **Legislative Assembly are not entitled to mileage expenses or a per diem and serve as volun-**
12 **teers on the task force. Other members of the task force are not entitled to compensation**
13 **or reimbursement for expenses and serve as volunteers on the task force.**

14 **“(15) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist**
15 **the task force in the performance of its duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating**
16 **to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force**
17 **consider necessary to perform their duties.”.**

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
