

House Bill 3149

Sponsored by Representative GORSEK

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Establishes Task Force on Community College Child Care Services.
Sunsets task force on date of convening of 2015 regular session of Legislative Assembly.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to community college childcare services; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Community College Child Care Services is established.**

5 **(2) The task force consists of members appointed by the Commissioner for Community**
6 **College Services. The commissioner shall appoint members who represent community college**
7 **administrators, community college faculty, community college students, the board of educa-**
8 **tion of a community college district, the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce**
9 **Development and the Child Care Division of the Employment Department. At least two**
10 **members of the task force must be community college faculty and at least two members of**
11 **the task force must be community college students.**

12 **(3) The task force shall:**

13 **(a) Study the cost of providing child care services to students of community colleges; and**

14 **(b) Identify sources for funding the cost of providing child care services to students of**
15 **community colleges.**

16 **(4) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a quorum for the transaction**
17 **of business.**

18 **(5) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the members**
19 **of the task force.**

20 **(6) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as chairperson.**

21 **(7) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the commissioner shall make an appointment to**
22 **become immediately effective.**

23 **(8) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson**
24 **or of a majority of the members of the task force.**

25 **(9) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.**

26 **(10) The task force shall submit a report, and may include recommendations for legis-**
27 **lation, to the interim legislative committees on education no later than September 1, 2014.**

28 **(11) The Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development shall provide**
29 **staff support to the task force.**

30 **(12) Members of the task force are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement for**
31 **expenses and serve as volunteers of the task force.**

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter *[italic and bracketed]* is existing law to be omitted.
New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

1 **(13) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist**
2 **the task force in the performance of its duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating**
3 **to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force**
4 **consider necessary to perform their duties.**

5 **SECTION 2.** Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on the date of the convening of the 2015
6 regular session of the Legislative Assembly as specified in ORS 171.010.

7 **SECTION 3.** This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
8 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect
9 on its passage.

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
