

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3160

1 On page 9 of the printed bill, line 17, after the period insert “The Attorney General may not
2 establish a rule under this subsection with respect to conduct that is subject to the Insurance Code
3 unless the Attorney General first submits the proposed rule to the Director of the Department of
4 Consumer and Business Services for review and approval.”.

5 In line 42, after the period insert “As soon as is practicable, the Attorney General shall provide
6 the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services with a copy of any complaint
7 or other initial pleading, and any judgment, that the Attorney General receives under this sub-
8 section in connection with an action that is related to insurance or involves a method, act or
9 practice that is also subject to the Insurance Code.”.

10 On page 11, delete lines 25 through 30 and insert:

11 “**SECTION 7. Section 8 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 646.605 to
12 646.652.**

13 “**SECTION 8. A prosecuting attorney may not take an action under ORS 646.618 or 646.632
14 with respect to an act or practice declared to be unlawful under ORS 646.607 or 646.608 if the
15 act or practice is related to insurance and otherwise subject to the Insurance Code unless
16 the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services first requests the pros-
17 ecuting attorney to take the action. The director may elect to be named as a party in any
18 action or proceeding the prosecuting attorney commences at the director’s request.**

19 “**SECTION 9. Section 8 of this 2013 Act and the amendments to ORS 646.605, 646.608,
20 646.636, 646.638 and 646.648 by sections 1 to 6 of this 2013 Act apply to proceedings that begin
21 on or after the effective date of this 2013 Act.**

22 “**SECTION 10. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
23 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect
24 on its passage.”.**
