

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3165

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

- 1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, after “amending” insert “ORS 291.229 and”.
- 2 In line 3, delete “repealing ORS 291.229;”.
- 3 In line 6, restore the bracketed material.
- 4 In line 15, restore the bracketed material.
- 5 On page 2, line 7, restore the period and delete the rest of the line.
- 6 In line 8, delete “unique or emergency circumstances.”.
- 7 In line 11, delete the second “or”.
- 8 In line 15, delete the period and insert “; or
- 9 “(c) The director determines is warranted because the state agency has supervisory employees
- 10 exercising authority over personnel who are not employees of the state agency, the state agency has
- 11 a significant number of part-time or seasonal employees or the state agency has another unique
- 12 personnel need.”.
- 13 On page 3, delete line 8 and insert:
- 14 “**SECTION 2.** ORS 291.229, as amended by section 2, chapter 101, Oregon Laws 2012, is
- 15 amended to read:
- 16 “291.229. [(1) *The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall develop a plan for state*
- 17 *agencies that employ more than 100 employees to attain a ratio of 11 to 1 of employees of state agencies*
- 18 *who are not supervisory employees to supervisory employees. The plan shall be used to develop the*
- 19 *legislatively adopted budget and may provide for a transition to the ratio specified in this subsection*
- 20 *during a period lasting more than one biennium.*]
- 21 “[2) *As part of the development of the legislatively adopted budget, during each odd-numbered year*
- 22 *regular session of the Legislative Assembly, the department shall report on the plan developed under*
- 23 *subsection (1) of this section to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The report shall include the*
- 24 *ratio of employees of state agencies who are not supervisory employees to supervisory employees.*]
- 25 “(1) **As part of the development of the legislatively adopted budget in each odd-numbered**
- 26 **year regular session of the Legislative Assembly, the Oregon Department of Administrative**
- 27 **Services shall make a report to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means on the actions**
- 28 **taken by state agencies during the previous biennium to attain a ratio of at least 11 nonsu-**
- 29 **pervisory employees to every supervisory employee, as defined in ORS 243.650.**
- 30 “[3) (2) As used in this section:
- 31 “[a) *‘Legislatively adopted budget’ means the budget enacted by the Legislative Assembly during*
- 32 *an odd-numbered year regular session.*]
- 33 “[b)(A)] (a) ‘State agency’ means all state officers, boards, commissions, departments, insti-
- 34 tutions, branches, agencies, divisions and other entities, without regard to the designation given to
- 35 those entities, that are within the executive department of government as described in [section 1,]

2 “[*B*] **(b)** ‘State agency’ does not include:
3 “[*i*] **(A)** The legislative department as defined in ORS 174.114;
4 “[*ii*] **(B)** The judicial department as defined in ORS 174.113;
5 “[*iii*] **(C)** The Public Defense Services Commission;
6 “[*iv*] **(D)** The Secretary of State and the State Treasurer in the performance of the duties of
7 their constitutional offices;
8 “[*v*] **(E)** Semi-independent state agencies listed in ORS 182.454;
9 “[*vi*] **(F)** The Oregon Tourism Commission;
10 “[*vii*] **(G)** The Oregon Film and Video Office;
11 “[*viii*] **(H)** The Oregon University System;
12 “[*ix*] **(I)** The Oregon Health and Science University;
13 “[*x*] **(J)** The Travel Information Council;
14 “[*xi*] **(K)** Oregon Corrections Enterprises;
15 “[*xii*] **(L)** The Oregon State Lottery Commission;
16 “[*xiii*] **(M)** The State Accident Insurance Fund Corporation;
17 “[*xiv*] **(N)** The Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation;
18 “[*xv*] **(O)** The Oregon Utility Notification Center;
19 “[*xvi*] **(P)** Oregon Community Power;
20 “[*xvii*] **(Q)** The Citizens’ Utility Board;
21 “[*xviii*] **(R)** A special government body as defined in ORS 174.117;
22 “[*xix*] **(S)** Any other public corporation created under a statute of this state and specifically
23 designated as a public corporation; and
24 “[*xx*] **(T)** Any other semi-independent state agency denominated by statute as a semi-
25 independent state agency.
26 “[*c*] ‘Supervisory employee’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 243.650.”.
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
