SUMMARY

Creates exemption from state preemption for local laws designed to prevent or control presence of pesticides in potable water.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to pesticides. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 634. 4 SECTION 2. This chapter does not limit the authority of a city, town, county or other 5 political subdivision of this state to adopt or enforce a local ordinance, rule or regulation for 6 7 the purpose of preventing or controlling the presence of pesticides in surface and ground 8 water used by the city, town, county or political subdivision as a source of potable water. 9
