House Bill 3182

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY (at the request of Oregon Law Commission)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Oregon Law Commission to appoint work group to study methods of selecting judges. Directs commission to report to committee or interim committee of Legislative Assembly on results of study before December 31, 2013.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to the selection of judges; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Law Commission shall appoint a work group to study and
5	evaluate the advantages and disadvantages of various methods of selecting judges.
6	(2) The commission shall report on the study to an appropriate committee or interim
7	committee of the Legislative Assembly before December 31, 2013.
8	SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
9	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect
10	on its passage.
