CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to notifications of misdemeanor convictions; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) A justice or municipal court shall notify the Department of State Police when the justice or municipal court enters a judgment of conviction for a Class A misdemeanor.

- (2) The department shall make rules establishing:
- (a) Requirements for notification under this section.
- (b) Procedures for entry of convictions described in subsection (1) of this section into the Law Enforcement Data System the department maintains. The rules must provide that it is not necessary to enter a conviction into the Law Enforcement Data System if a record of the conviction already exists in the system.

SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2013 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2014.

(2) The Department of State Police may take any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section to enable the department to exercise, on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all the duties, functions and powers conferred on the department by section 1 of this 2013 Act.

SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
