

House Bill 3198

Sponsored by Representative NATHANSON; Representatives BARKER, GARRETT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires justice or municipal court to notify Department of State Police when court enters judgment of conviction of Class A misdemeanor.

Directs department to make rules for entry of convictions into Law Enforcement Data System.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to notifications of misdemeanor convictions; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) A justice or municipal court shall notify the Department of State Police**
5 **when the justice or municipal court enters a judgment of conviction for a Class A**
6 **misdemeanor.**

7 **(2) The department shall make rules establishing:**

8 **(a) Requirements for notification under this section.**

9 **(b) Procedures for entry of convictions described in subsection (1) of this section into the**
10 **Law Enforcement Data System the department maintains. The rules must provide that it is**
11 **not necessary to enter a conviction into the Law Enforcement Data System if a record of**
12 **the conviction already exists in the system.**

13 **SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2013 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2014.**

14 **(2) The Department of State Police may take any action before the operative date speci-**
15 **fied in subsection (1) of this section to enable the department to exercise, on and after the**
16 **operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all the duties, functions and powers**
17 **conferred on the department by section 1 of this 2013 Act.**

18 **SECTION 3. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
19 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**
20 **on its passage.**
