

House Bill 3224

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HUMAN SERVICES AND HOUSING

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Transportation to conduct study of changing design of driver licenses, driver permits and identification cards to distinctively mark those issued to persons under 18 years of age.

Sunsets January 2, 2016.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to transportation.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall conduct a study of the efficacy**
5 **and cost of creating and implementing a system for issuing distinctively marked driver li-**
6 **enses, driver permits and identification cards to persons under 18 years of age.**

7 **(2) The department shall report the results of the study, along with any recommen-**
8 **dations, to the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly not later than January 30, 2015.**

9 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2, 2016.**
