CHAPTER .....

AN ACT

Relating to inmate labor; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 421.

**SECTION 2.** An inmate in the custody of the Department of Corrections may not perform electrical or plumbing work unless under the direct supervision of a regular status employee of the department who is a licensed electrician or plumber. An inmate may perform electrical or plumbing work only at a facility owned or leased by the department.

**SECTION 3.** This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
