

House Bill 3247

Sponsored by Representative UNGER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to establish process for person to file grievances against facility that houses released inmates but that is not licensed. Requires process to include right of authority to enter facility, cease further placements and impose fine.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to supportive housing.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "site specific supportive housing" means a home**
5 **or facility that contracts with a county or a state agency to house released inmates and that**
6 **is not subject to ORS 443.410.**

7 **(2) The Oregon Health Authority shall establish a process by which an organization,**
8 **governmental entity or private citizen may file a complaint about a site specific supportive**
9 **housing unit. The process must include, but is not limited to:**

10 **(a) Authorization for the authority to enter the unit within 24 hours of receipt of the**
11 **complaint to investigate the complaint; and**

12 **(b) If the complaint is founded and the basis of the complaint warrants such action:**

13 **(A) A mechanism for ceasing all additional placements for a period of not less than six**
14 **months; and**

15 **(B) Authorization for the authority to impose an appropriate fine against the unit.**
