2	"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
3	"(a) 'Gross vehicle weight rating' has the meaning given that term in ORS 801.298.
4	"(b) 'Motor vehicle' has the meaning given that term in ORS 801.360.
5	"(2) A person may not operate a motor vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating that
6	is greater than 200 pounds, a Class I all-terrain vehicle as defined in ORS 801.190, a Class I
7	all-terrain vehicle as defined in ORS 801.193, a Class III all-terrain vehicle as defined in ORS
8	801.194 (1) or a Class IV all-terrain vehicle as defined in ORS 801.194 (2) in the beds or banks
9	of any waterway in the Common School Forest Lands or the Elliott State Forest Lands des
10	ignated and set aside as described in ORS 530.450 to 530.520.
11	"(3) This section does not apply to a person:
12	"(a) Operating a vehicle described in subsection (2) of this section that is owned by the
13	state, a local government as defined in ORS 174.116 or the federal government.
14	"(b) Operating a vehicle described in subsection (2) of this section while the person is
15	performing work under a contract with the state, a local government as defined in ORS
16	174.116 or the federal government.
17	"(c) Operating a vehicle described in subsection (2) of this section while the person is
18	engaged in rescue, recovery or emergency activities.
19	"(d) Operating a vehicle described in subsection (2) of this section while crossing the beds
20	or banks of any waterway in forestlands specified in subsection (2) of this section directly
21	from a road surface on one side of the waterway to a road surface immediately opposite or
22	the other side of the waterway.
23	"(e) Who is a licensed hunter while engaged in hunting activities in compliance with state
24	or federal law.
25	"(f) Operating a vehicle described in subsection (2) of this section while engaged in other
26	activities specified in rules adopted by the Department of State Lands, after consultation
27	with the State Forester.
28	"(g) Operating a boat as defined in ORS 830.005.
