

**SENATE AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3253**

1 On page 2 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 30 through 34 and insert:

2 “(c) Has been convicted in another United States court of a crime:

3 “(A) That would constitute a sex crime if committed in this state; or

4 “(B) For which the person would have to register as a sex offender in that court’s jurisdiction,
5 or as required under federal law, regardless of whether the crime would constitute a sex crime in
6 this state; or”.

7 On page 3, delete lines 5 through 8 and insert:

8 “(b) Is paroled to this state under ORS 144.610 after being convicted in another United States
9 court of a crime:

10 “(A) That would constitute a sex crime if committed in this state; or

11 “(B) For which the person would have to register as a sex offender in that court’s jurisdiction,
12 or as required under federal law, regardless of whether the crime would constitute a sex crime in
13 this state; or”.

14 On page 4, delete lines 7 through 10 and insert:

15 “(c) To or in this state under ORS 144.610 after being convicted in another United States court
16 of a crime:

17 “(A) That would constitute a sex crime if committed in this state; or

18 “(B) For which the person would have to register as a sex offender in that court’s jurisdiction,
19 regardless of whether the crime would constitute a sex crime in this state.”.

20 On page 6, delete lines 6 through 12 and insert:

21 “(6) Subsections (1) to (5) of this section apply to a person convicted in another United States
22 court of a crime:

23 “(a) That would constitute a sex crime if committed in this state; or

24 “(b) For which the person would have to register as a sex offender in that court’s jurisdiction,
25 or as required under federal law, regardless of whether the crime would constitute a sex crime in
26 this state.”.
