

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3260

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 9, delete “primary” and insert “health”.  
2 In line 14, delete “primary” and insert “health”.  
3 In line 16, after “Includes” insert “effective”.  
4 In line 17, delete “consumer” and insert “person”.  
5 In line 22, delete “Integrates” and insert “Includes”.  
6 After line 22, insert:  
7 “(r) Provides equitable access to health care, according to a person’s needs.  
8 “(s) Is affordable for individuals, families, businesses and society.”.  
9 In line 23, after “(2)” insert “To the extent practicable using only the funds received under  
10 section 2 of this 2013 Act,”.  
11 Delete lines 26 through 30 and insert:  
12 “(a) An option for a publicly financed single-payer model for financing privately delivered health  
13 care, that is decoupled from employment and allows commercial insurance coverage only of supple-  
14 mental health services not paid for under the option.  
15 “(b) An option that allows a person to choose between a publicly funded plan, including a basic  
16 health program under 42 U.S.C. 18051, and pri-”.  
17 On page 2, delete lines 9 through 11 and insert:  
18 “(d) An option for a plan that provides essential health benefits, including preventive care and  
19 hospital services, and that:  
20 “(A) Is funded by a broad based and constitutionally dedicated sales tax that does not tax in-  
21 come or payroll;  
22 “(B) Allows a person to access the commercial market to purchase coverage that is not covered  
23 under the plan;  
24 “(C) Limits the role of the plan to collecting and distributing revenue while preserving private  
25 sector delivery options and optimizing consumer choice;  
26 “(D) Offers to Oregonians who earn more than 400 percent of the federal poverty guidelines a  
27 deductible plan that could be contributed to by employees and employers;  
28 “(E) Exempts Oregonians who earn no more than 400 percent of the federal poverty guidelines  
29 from deductibles;  
30 “(F) Accesses all sources of available federal funding; and  
31 “(G) Identifies program savings that can be achieved by providing health care coverage to all  
32 Oregonians, including but not limited to using the program to replace the state medical assistance  
33 program and the medical portion of worker’s compensation, then applies the savings to finance the  
34 plan.”.  
35 In line 12, after “researchers” insert “conducting the study”.

1 In line 37, delete “and”.

2 In line 38, delete the period and insert “; and

3 “(F) Estimates the potential savings to local governments and government agencies that cur-

4 rently administer health care programs, provide health care premium subsidies or provide funding

5 for health care services.”.

6 In line 41, after the semicolon insert “and”.

7 Delete lines 42 through 45.

8 On page 3, line 1, delete “(d)” and insert “(b)”.

9 In line 2, after “care” insert a period and delete the rest of the line.

10 In line 3, delete “solicit” and insert “accept”.

11 After line 16, insert:

12 **“SECTION 4. Sections 1 and 2 of this 2013 Act are repealed on January 2, 2016.”.**

13 In line 17, delete “4” and insert “5”.

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
