

House Bill 3266

Sponsored by Representative BENTZ; Representatives HICKS, HUFFMAN, SMITH

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Permits waste collection vehicles to stop, stand or park to collect solid waste, recyclable material or yard debris.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to waste collection vehicles; amending ORS 811.560.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 811.560 is amended to read:

5 811.560. This section provides exemptions from ORS 811.550 and 811.555. The following ex-
6 emptions are applicable as provided under ORS 811.550:

7 (1) When applicable, this subsection exempts school buses or worker transport buses stopped on
8 a roadway to load or unload workers or children, providing that the flashing school bus safety lights
9 on the bus are operating.

10 (2) When applicable, this subsection exempts vehicles stopped, standing or parked momentarily
11 to pick up or discharge a passenger.

12 (3) When applicable, this subsection exempts vehicles stopped, standing or parked momentarily
13 for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading property or passengers.

14 (4) When applicable, this subsection exempts vehicles owned or operated by the state, a county
15 or city when stopping, standing or parking is necessary to perform maintenance or repair work on
16 the roadway.

17 (5) When applicable, this subsection exempts vehicles from the prohibitions and penalties when
18 the driver's disregard of the prohibitions is necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic.

19 (6) When applicable, this subsection exempts vehicles acting in compliance with law or at the
20 direction of a police officer or a traffic control device.

21 (7) When applicable, this subsection exempts the driver of a vehicle that is disabled in such
22 manner and to such extent that the driver cannot avoid stopping or temporarily leaving the disabled
23 vehicle in a prohibited position.

24 (8) When applicable, this subsection exempts vehicles owned or operated by the State Depart-
25 ment of Fish and Wildlife when stopping, standing or parking is necessary to enable employees to
26 release fish.

27 (9) When applicable, this subsection exempts vehicles momentarily stopped to allow oncoming
28 traffic to pass before making a right-hand or left-hand turn or momentarily stopped in preparation
29 for or while negotiating an exit from the road.

30 **(10) When applicable, this subsection exempts commercial vehicles that are stopped,**
31 **standing or parked when stopping, standing or parking is necessary to engage in any activity**
