## House Bill 3383

Sponsored by Representative PARRISH; Representatives ESQUIVEL, MCLANE, WEIDNER, Senator OLSEN

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires Oregon Health Authority to compile and update database of health data and evidence-based research that is available online and searchable according to specified criteria.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to online health information.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall compile and continuously update a
5	database containing aggregate health data and evidence-based health research on the:
6	(a) Topics of age, race, ethnicity, sex, sexual orientation and other factors identified by
7	the authority; and
8	(b) Impacts on health of economic factors such as poverty and homelessness.
9	(2) The database must be publicly available so that a person can perform an Internet
10	search by entering the factors described in subsection (1) of this section to produce:
11	(a) Search results relevant to the health issues faced by an individual with a profile
12	composed of the factors; and
13	(b) Links to evidence-based research on related topics.

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

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
