

House Bill 3402

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON VETERANS' SERVICES AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides that certain persons who apply for driver license, driver permit or identification card be deemed to have consented to registration with Selective Service System.

2 Relating to applications to the Department of Transportation.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle**
5 **Code.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) A person who applies to the Department of Transportation for issuance**
7 **or renewal of a driver license, a driver permit or an identification card shall be deemed to**
8 **have given consent to being registered with the Selective Service System if the person is**
9 **required by federal law to register.**

10 **(2) The department shall place on the person's application notice that submission of the**
11 **application constitutes consent to being registered with the Selective Service System.**

12 **(3) The department shall adopt rules for the implementation and administration of this**
13 **section.**

14 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2013 Act applies to applications submitted on or after the**
15 **effective date of this 2013 Act.**
