SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides that certain persons who apply for driver license, driver permit or identification card be deemed to have consented to registration with Selective Service System.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to applications to the Department of Transportation. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle 4 Code. 5 6 SECTION 2. (1) A person who applies to the Department of Transportation for issuance or renewal of a driver license, a driver permit or an identification card shall be deemed to 7 8 have given consent to being registered with the Selective Service System if the person is 9 required by federal law to register. (2) The department shall place on the person's application notice that submission of the 10 application constitutes consent to being registered with the Selective Service System. 11 12 (3) The department shall adopt rules for the implementation and administration of this 13section. SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2013 Act applies to applications submitted on or after the 14 effective date of this 2013 Act. 1516
