

House Bill 3417

Sponsored by Representative WEIDNER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Makes retroactive legislation allowing owner to repurchase condemned property under certain circumstances if required provision not included in agreement for acquisition of property.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to eminent domain; amending section 2, chapter 426, Oregon Laws 2011; and declaring an
3 emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 2, chapter 426, Oregon Laws 2011, is amended to read:

6 **Sec. 2.** The amendments to ORS 35.385 by section 1 [*of this 2011 Act*], **chapter 426, Oregon**
7 **Laws 2011**, apply [*only*] to **all** agreements for acquisition by a condemner as described in ORS 35.385
8 (1) [*that are*], **whether** entered into **before**, on or after [*the effective date of this 2011 Act*] **June 17,**
9 **2011.**

10 **SECTION 2.** **This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**
12 **on its passage.**
