House Bill 3417

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Makes retroactive legislation allowing owner to repurchase condemned property under certain circumstances if required provision not included in agreement for acquisition of property. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to eminent domain; amending section 2, chapter 426, Oregon Laws 2011; and declaring an 2 3 emergency. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. Section 2, chapter 426, Oregon Laws 2011, is amended to read: 5 Sec. 2. The amendments to ORS 35.385 by section 1 [of this 2011 Act], chapter 426, Oregon 6 7 Laws 2011, apply [only] to all agreements for acquisition by a condemner as described in ORS 35.385 (1) [that are], whether entered into before, on or after [the effective date of this 2011 Act] June 17, 8 2011. 9 10 SECTION 2. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect 11 12 on its passage. 13
