House Bill 3418

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs State Board of Pharmacy to classify scopolamine as controlled substance in Schedule I or, if used for currently accepted medical use, Schedule III. Specifies date by which board must classify scopolamine.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 475.005 to
5	475.285.
6	SECTION 2. (1) The State Board of Pharmacy shall classify scopolamine as a controlled
7	substance in Schedule I.
8	(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, scopolamine shall be classified as a
9	controlled substance in Schedule III for purposes of currently accepted medical use in
10	treatment in the United States within the meaning of 21 U.S.C. 812(b)(3).
11	SECTION 3. The State Board of Pharmacy shall classify scopolamine in accordance with
12	section 2 of this 2013 Act no later than 180 days after the effective date of this 2013 Act.
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
