

# House Bill 3418

Sponsored by Representative WEIDNER; Representatives ESQUIVEL, HICKS

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs State Board of Pharmacy to classify scopolamine as controlled substance in Schedule I or, if used for currently accepted medical use, Schedule III. Specifies date by which board must classify scopolamine.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to controlled substances.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2013 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 475.005 to**  
5 **475.285.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) The State Board of Pharmacy shall classify scopolamine as a controlled**  
7 **substance in Schedule I.**

8 **(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, scopolamine shall be classified as a**  
9 **controlled substance in Schedule III for purposes of currently accepted medical use in**  
10 **treatment in the United States within the meaning of 21 U.S.C. 812(b)(3).**

11 **SECTION 3. The State Board of Pharmacy shall classify scopolamine in accordance with**  
12 **section 2 of this 2013 Act no later than 180 days after the effective date of this 2013 Act.**  
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**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
