

House Bill 3430

Sponsored by Representative WEIDNER; Representatives HOYLE, KENY-GUYER, THOMPSON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules requiring physician or midwife to inform mother or father after birth of child about benefits of testing infants for Krabbe disease.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

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Relating to Krabbe disease.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall adopt rules requiring physicians licensed under ORS chapter 677 and midwives who are attending a mother at the birth of a child to inform the mother or father as soon as practicable after the birth of the child about the benefits of testing an infant for Krabbe disease.
