Directs Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules requiring physician or midwife to inform mother or father after birth of child about benefits of testing infants for Krabbe disease.

4	SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall adopt rules requiring physicians licensed
5	under ORS chapter 677 and midwives who are attending a mother at the birth of a child to
6	inform the mother or father as soon as practicable after the birth of the child about the
7	benefits of testing an infant for Krabbe disease.
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
