House Bill 3491

Sponsored by Representative BENTZ, Senator HANSELL; Senator WHITSETT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs Governor to report to Legislative Assembly on matters related to Columbia River Treaty.

Sunsets January 2, 2025.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to the Columbia River Treaty; and declaring an emergency.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> At least once every six months, the Governor shall report to the Legislative Assembly, in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, regarding:
 - (1) The status of the Columbia River Treaty 2014/2024 Review undertaken by the Bonneville Power Administration and the United States Army Corps of Engineers;
 - (2) Participation by the Governor, or any state agency, in the Columbia River Treaty 2014/2024 Review, in particular any input provided by the Governor or state agency regarding the interests of this state, including irrigation, water supply and fish resources; and
 - (3) Any input provided by the Governor, or any state agency, into the review regarding whether to continue, modify or terminate the treaty.
- SECTION 2. The first report under section 1 of this 2013 Act is due not later than December 31, 2013.
 - SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2013 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
 - <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
