

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3494

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, after line 10, insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, ‘Armed Forces of the United States’ has the**
3 **meaning given that term in ORS 348.282.**

4 **“(2) Subject to subsection (3) of this section, to recognize and honor those who were**
5 **killed in action or who died as a result of wounds received in action while serving in the**
6 **Armed Forces of the United States, the Department of Transportation shall erect and**
7 **maintain a Fallen Hero roadside memorial sign for:**

8 **“(a) Eric McKinley, on Oregon Route 34 near milepost 50.**

9 **“(b) Tyler Troyer, on Oregon Route 34 near milepost 4.**

10 **“(c) Adam Buyes, on Oregon Route 22 near milepost 20.**

11 **“(3) The department may not erect a Fallen Hero roadside memorial sign until the de-**
12 **partment receives the payment of a fee. The department shall determine the amount of the**
13 **fee by rule, except that the fee may not exceed the direct and indirect expenses associated**
14 **with erecting, maintaining and removing a roadside memorial sign.**

15 **“(4) The department shall deposit the fees that the department collects under this section**
16 **into the Roadside Memorial Fund established under ORS 366.932.**

17 **“(5) A public body, as defined in ORS 174.109, may not expend moneys for the purpose**
18 **of paying the fee required under subsection (3) of this section.**

19 **“(6) The department, by rule, shall establish the size, design and location of a roadside**
20 **memorial sign erected under this section. The sign must include the name of the individual**
21 **the sign is recognizing.”.**

22 In line 11, delete “2” and insert “3”.

23 In line 15, delete “section 1” and insert “sections 1 and 2”.
