

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3528

By COMMITTEE ON RULES

June 28

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon delete the rest of the line and insert
2 “creating new provisions; amending ORS 171.745; and declaring an emergency.”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 31 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 171.745 is amended to read:

5 “171.745. (1) A lobbyist registered with the Oregon Government Ethics Commission or required
6 to register with the commission shall, according to the schedule described in ORS 171.752, file with
7 the commission a statement showing for the applicable reporting period:

8 “(a) The total amount of all moneys expended for food, refreshments and entertainment by the
9 lobbyist for the purpose of lobbying.

10 “(b) The name of any legislative **official** or executive official to whom or for whose benefit, on
11 any one occasion, an expenditure is made for the purposes of lobbying, and the date, name of payee,
12 purpose and amount of that expenditure. This paragraph applies if the total amount expended on the
13 occasion by one or more persons exceeds \$50.

14 “(2) Statements required by this section need not include:

15 “(a) Amounts expended by the lobbyist for personal living and travel expenses and office over-
16 head, including salaries and wages paid for staff and secretarial assistance, and maintenance
17 expenses[.]; or

18 “(b) **Amounts expended by the lobbyist on lobbying another lobbyist who is registered**
19 **with the commission or required to register with the commission, or on lobbying any person**
20 **on whose behalf a lobbyist is registered or required to register. This paragraph does not ap-**
21 **ply if the person lobbied is a legislative official, an executive official or a member of a state**
22 **board or commission.**

23 “(3) If the amount of any expenditure required to be included in a statement is not accurately
24 known at the time the statement is required to be filed, an estimate of the expenditure shall be
25 submitted in the statement and designated as an estimate. The exact amount expended for which
26 a previous estimate was made shall be submitted in a subsequent report when the information is
27 available.

28 “[3] (4) A statement required by this section shall include a copy of any notice provided to a
29 public official or candidate under ORS 244.100.

30 “[4] (5) For each statement required by this section, an entity [*comprised*] **composed** of more
31 than one lobbyist may file one statement that reports expenditures by the entity and not by indi-
32 vidual lobbyists.

33 “**SECTION 2.** ORS 171.745, as amended by section 1 of this 2013 Act, is amended to read:

34 “171.745. (1) A lobbyist registered with the Oregon Government Ethics Commission or required
35 to register with the commission shall, according to the schedule described in ORS 171.752, file with

1 the commission a statement showing for the applicable reporting period:

2 “(a) The total amount of all moneys expended for food, refreshments and entertainment by the
3 lobbyist for the purpose of lobbying.

4 “(b) The name of any legislative official or executive official to whom or for whose benefit, on
5 any one occasion, an expenditure is made for the purposes of lobbying, and the date, name of payee,
6 purpose and amount of that expenditure. This paragraph applies if the total amount expended on the
7 occasion by one or more persons exceeds \$50.

8 “(2) Statements required by this section need not include[:]

9 “[*(a)*] amounts expended by the lobbyist for personal living and travel expenses and office over-
10 head, including salaries and wages paid for staff and secretarial assistance, and maintenance ex-
11 penses. [*; or*]

12 “[*(b)* *Amounts expended by the lobbyist on lobbying another lobbyist who is registered with the*
13 *commission or required to register with the commission, or on lobbying any person on whose behalf a*
14 *lobbyist is registered or required to register. This paragraph does not apply if the person lobbied is a*
15 *legislative official, an executive official or a member of a state board or commission.*]

16 “(3) If the amount of any expenditure required to be included in a statement is not accurately
17 known at the time the statement is required to be filed, an estimate of the expenditure shall be
18 submitted in the statement and designated as an estimate. The exact amount expended for which
19 a previous estimate was made shall be submitted in a subsequent report when the information is
20 available.

21 “(4) A statement required by this section shall include a copy of any notice provided to a public
22 official or candidate under ORS 244.100.

23 “(5) For each statement required by this section, an entity composed of more than one lobbyist
24 may file one statement that reports expenditures by the entity and not by individual lobbyists.

25 “**SECTION 3. The amendments to ORS 171.745 by section 2 of this 2013 Act become op-**
26 **erative on June 30, 2015.**

27 “**SECTION 4. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
28 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**
29 **on its passage.”.**
