SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Commission for the Blind for biennial expenses. Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by commission.

Limits biennial expenditures by commission from federal funds.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Commission for the Blind; appropriating money; lim-2

iting expenditures; and declaring an emergency. 3

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Commission for the Blind, for the biennium

beginning July 1, 2013, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,064,346 for operations of 6

7 the commission.

8 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$3,077,800 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for 9 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, 10 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Commission for 11 12 the Blind. SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 13

\$10,685,997 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for 14 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Commission for the 1516 Blind.

SECTION 4. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 17peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect 18 19 July 1, 2013.
