SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Department of Energy for landscape level planning in facility siting.]

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by [department] State Department of Energy.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys. Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds. Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the State Department of Energy; limiting expenditures;

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 6 \$36,766,495 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for 7 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, 8 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Department 9 of Energy.

10 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 11 \$2,166,050 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for 12 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-13 nomic Development Fund to the State Department of Energy for debt service for the energy 14 efficiency and sustainable technology loan program, for the Home Energy Efficiency Program

15 and for State Energy Loan Program recapitalization.

16 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 17 \$2,939,533 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for

payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the State Department of Energy.

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20 <u>SECTION 4.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, expenditures by the State Depart-

- 21 ment of Energy for loans for small scale energy loan projects and expenditures by the de-
- 22 partment for debt service are not limited.
- 23 <u>SECTION 5.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
