CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the State Department of Energy; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the State Department of Energy and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved as follows for the business energy tax credit:

	\$25,000 \$ 0.25% of
	tax credit
(2)	Pass-through fee without
	department assistance \$ 100 per
	tax certificate
	issued
(3)	Tax credit transfer fee \$ 200, plus
	\$100 per tax
	certificate

<u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect July 1, 2013.
