- 24 **“(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made**
- 25 **to the Judicial Department by section 15, chapter 600, Oregon Laws 2011, for the biennium**
- 26 **beginning July 1, 2011, is increased by \$595,111 for third party debt collection fees.**
- 27 **“SECTION 10. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
- 28 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**
- 29 **on its passage.”.**
