Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Justice for biennial expenses. [Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Justice for payment of debt service on bonds for replacement of Child Support Program data system.] Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Re-ceipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department. Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.
