## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Business Development Department for Oregon Arts Commission and [Infrastructure Finance Authority] Article XI-Q bond debt service.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys for certain purposes. Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds for certain purposes. Authorizes certain nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

27 <u>SECTION 6.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 28 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect 29 July 1, 2013.
