[Appropriates moneys from General Fund to _____ for biennial expenses.] [Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by _____.]

[Limits biennial expenditures of _____ from federal funds.] Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for Oregon Health and Science University for certain biennial expenses. Limits payment of certain expenses from Oregon Health and Science University Bond Fund.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
6	ated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July
7	1, 2013, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for Oregon Health and Science
8	University:

10	general services \$ 58,685,186
11	(2) Child Development and
12	Rehabilitation Center \$ 7,710,000
13	(3) University hospitals and clinics

15	Oregon Poison Center \$ 2,467,201
16	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
17	\$31,639,826 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for
18	payment of expenses by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services from the Oregon
19	Health and Science University Bond Fund for the following purposes:
20	(1) Paying the principal of, and the interest and premium on, outstanding general obli-
21	gation bonds;
22	(2) Funding the general obligation bond reserves; and
23	(3) Paying amounts due in connection with any instrument authorized by section 18
24	(4)(c), chapter 921, Oregon Laws 2001.
