House Bill 5031**

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to [_____] **Oregon Department of Administrative Services for Oregon University System** for biennial expenses.

[Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by _____.]

[Limits biennial expenditures of _____ from federal funds.]

Limits biennial expenditures by Oregon University System from lottery moneys for debt service on lottery bonds.

Limits biennial expenditures by Oregon University System from lottery moneys allocated from Sports Lottery Account.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for use by the Oregon University System, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:

16 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
 17 **\$25,571,489 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for**
 18 **payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated to the Oregon University System from**
 19 **the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund for debt service on lottery bonds**
 20 **sold for the benefit of Oregon public universities.**

21 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
 22 **\$8,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for**
 23 **payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated to the Oregon University System from**
 24 **the Sports Lottery Account for the benefit of Oregon public universities.**

25 **SECTION 4. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
 26 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect**
 27 **July 1, 2013.**
