## **A-Engrossed** House Bill 5031

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

16 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 17 \$25,571,489 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for 18 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated to the Oregon University System from 19 the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund for debt service on lottery bonds 20 sold for the benefit of Oregon public universities.

21 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 22 \$8,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for 23 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated to the Oregon University System from 24 the Sports Lottery Account for the benefit of Oregon public universities.

25 <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 26 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect 27 July 1, 2013.
