## House Bill 5034

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by State Parks and Recreation Department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys for certain purposes. Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds for certain purposes. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2013.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the State Parks and Recreation Department; limiting 3 expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts 6 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limits for payment 7 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-

8 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Parks and Recre-

9 ation Department, for the following purposes:

16 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts

17 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limits for payment

18 of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources Fund to

19 the State Parks and Recreation Department, for the following purposes:

12 <u>SECTION 5.</u> This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect
July 1, 2013.

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
